Biomedical Engineering





Now for application!

The SJTU-KTH joint summer school of biomedical engineering started in 2012 annually, taking place either in Shanghai or Stockholm. This year's joint summer school will be from Aug 21 to Aug 26, 2016 in Shanghai Jiao Tong University.

Different from previous SJTU-KTH joint summer schools, in this year, the students will be grouped with 4 or 5 students in each, jointly working on an assigned project, which is prepared before the start of the week. The summer school week will start with a brief orientation, followed by four full days of laboratory group work. And in the final day, each group will present a draft of their project reports, with final delivery one month later.

Student participants will be allotted to different projects. These projects will be successively presented at the web pages of both the School of Biomedical Engineering of SJTU and life science platform of KTH . An application for participation should include the prioritized preferences by the students.

SJTU will cover the local accommodations (food and hotels) during the summer school for all KTH students and faculty members. KTH will give a contribution towards travel costs for PhD students.

We encourage the graduate students and senior undergraduates in biomedical engineering, or those who are interested in the SJTU-KTH dual MSc/Ph.D. biomedical engineering programs to apply for the SJTU-KTH summer school.
